Thursday, 27 April Business Action for Humanitarian Needs Karen Smith works with the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) Private Sector Section (PSS) as a Business Partnership Advisor working with companies to improve humanitarian effectiveness. In this position she has deployed on emergency assignments as the private sector focal point for the Typhoon Haiyan response in the Philippines and the Ebola response in West Africa. Karen has also worked with the OCHA Central Emergency Response Fund managing the allocation of approximately USD 300 million in projects a year.

Prior to working with OCHA she worked with the UN DPKO in Kosovo as a Coordinator for the Regionals return unit, as a Best Practices Officer in Sudan and as a Coordinator for the Guidance team for the Peacekeeping Best Practices Section in NY. In addition to working with the UN she's held management positions with a number of NGOs, a decentralized fund for the Canadian International Development Agency and as Director of CSR Projects for Business for Social Responsibility.

Karen holds a MSc.in Responsibility and Business Practice from the University of Bath, a Cross Sector Partnership Certificate from Cambridge University, a PBD in Community Economic Development from Simon Fraser University, and a B.A. in International Development Studies from University of Toronto.
